

Step 5

Note: If you have not set up a Pearson VUE web account for C++ Institute exams yet, you need to do this prior to connecting the two accounts. For assistance regarding how to start a Pearson VUE web account, please consult a separate guide. To create a Pearson VUE web account, click the **Create account at Pearson VUE** button.

Note # 2: Each time you make a smallest change to your data on your Pearson VUE account, it takes 7 days before that change can be detected by our C/C++ Education Portal system at www.education.cppinstitute.org. This also includes starting a new Pearson VUE account at www.pearsonvue.com/cpp/, which means that **IF YOU SET UP A PEARSON VUE WEB ACCOUNT LESS THAN 7 DAYS AGO, YOU WILL NEED TO WAIT ONE FULL WEEK BEFORE YOU CAN INITIATE THE CONNECTION PROCESS.**

Note # 3: Please make sure the email address on both accounts, i.e. your C++ Institute account at C/C++ Education Portal (www.education.cppinstitute.org) and your Pearson VUE web account (www.pearsonvue.com/cpp/) looks exactly the same. The email address is case-sensitive. If you have changed the email address on your Pearson VUE account so that it is the same on both accounts, it takes 7 days before that change can be detected by our C/C++ Education Portal system. This means you need to wait one full week before you can initiate the connection process.

Step 6

Paste the **C++ Institute Testing ID** you have previously copied from your Pearson VUE web account.

Connecting with Pearson Vue

Your data on Pearson VUE account will be verified just before your exam at a Pearson VUE Authorized Test Centre. That is why once you have connected your CPP account with your Pearson VUE account, the only way to update your profile information on both accounts will be by changing it at Pearson VUE. The updated information will usually be implemented by C++ Institute within 48 hours.

If you do not have your Pearson VUE account yet, please create one by clicking [here](#) and selecting My Account from the menu on the right.

Click the **Connect** button to initiate the connection process. The connection is usually made within 24 hours.

Possible issues and solutions

Issue:

No Pearson Vue account with that ID. If you created it recently, please wait one day and try again.

Solutions:

- Please make sure you provided a correct C++ Institute Testing ID. Re-enter the CPI ID and click the Connect button once again.
- You set up your Pearson VUE web account less than 7 days ago. Please wait one full week and try to connect the two accounts again.
- You have not started a Pearson VUE web account. Please set up an account, wait 7 days and initiate the connection.

Issue:

Pearson Vue e-mail address is different than your address. Please change it and then try again.

Solutions:

- Change your email address on your Pearson VUE web account so that it matches the email address on your C++ Institute student account. Please make sure the email address on both accounts is exactly the same, including lower and upper-case characters. Then wait 7 days and try to connect the two accounts again.
- Alternatively, contact C++ Institute at support@cppinstitute.org and request that your email address on your C++ Institute student account be changed to match the email address on your Pearson VUE web account.

Note: Once the two accounts have been connected, you can no longer change your data on your C++ Institute student account. The only way to do so is by changing your data on your Pearson VUE web account.
